



Which circle are you in?

Everyone falls inside of one of the above circles.

The first circle shows the cross to be outside of the man's world. His existence is alone and no matter how much he accumulates inside his circle he is a beggar without God.

The second circle shows the second state of man. Everyone is either lost or saved and the second man is saved, the cross is inside his world, but notice who is seated on the throne of his life.
