Jeshoshaphat was told 3 things as he faced a multitude of enemies in 2Chron. 20.

1. He would not have to fight.
2. But he would have to position himself for victory.
3. Don't be afraid and go out singing.

This is still heaven's recipe for victory.

None of us can battle ourselves and gain victory. It is only in the Lord that we can do anything. He will never interfere as long as you have your hand on it. But when you turn to him completely, then "He will fight". Many people feel they have to help God. Sarah tried to help and got Ishmael into the world, but it didn't help do what only the Spirit of God can do.

Position yourself for victory: this is the greatest truth in this whole context.

Is your mind in a posture of faith and victory? Do you believe God, his Word, his promises? Are you looking for miracles, and breakthroughs?

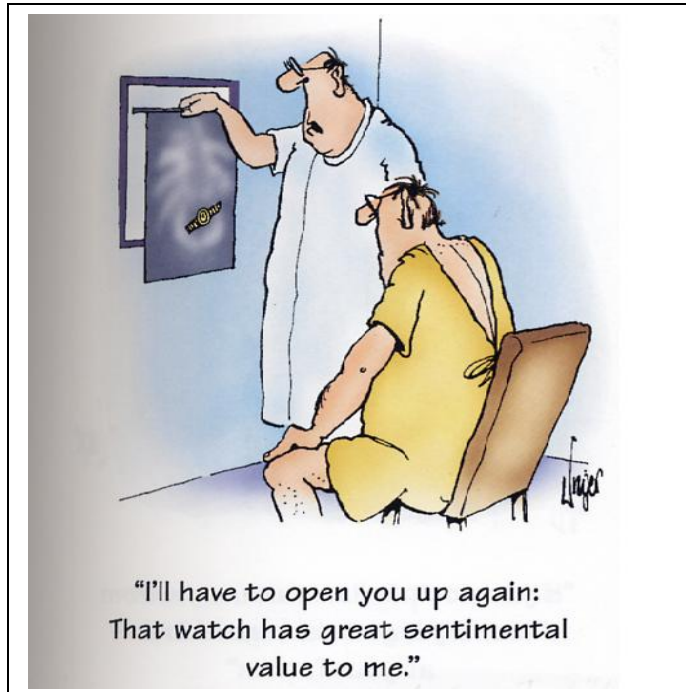

Put a big smile on your face. Put a shout in your voice, get ready, God is about to break through and he wants to find us in the "posture of victory".

The position is a standing position: the posture of victory is fixed. Don't move, don't run, don't change churches just because the battle is hard. Hang in, hold on, stand fast in the liberty. Standing still is the hardest thing you will ever do when your family is under attack, your children are in trouble, or your marriage is crumbling. We all hit the panic mode and want to fix it. God says, "hold steady" and sing. Yes that's right "sing". Singing was the attack mode for Israel, they went out

praising the Lord. Since they weren't going to be on the playing field they joined the band. Singing praises gets your mind off of people and issues and keeps your focus upward. This is spiritual warfare at its highest level. To ignore the devil's attacks and sing and stay in peace is the ultimate put down of Lucifer.

God help us all to pick up our heads and come out singing, holding our ground the whole time.
