

Which Cannot Be Uttered

This great phrase from Romans 8:26 is a hinge upon which all praying moves. When we pray in tongues the Holy Spirit comes to our aid because of two things:

1. Our weaknesses: "weaknesses" is plural. There are many things we are weak in, but the Spirit gives us strength simultaneously in all these areas when we pray in tongues.

2. Our ignorance: "for we know not what we should pray for as we should". We know so little about the needs we face. Even our own hearts, we really don't understand why we feel the way we do, or what God is doing at any given time in our own hearts. The great release is we can pray in tongues and the Holy Ghost will pray powerfully and perfectly in the will of God for us. He hits the mark every time. He knows exactly where we are and works skillfully when we yield to Him in prayer.

"Which cannot be uttered" – describes the deep mystery, the effectiveness, the yearning God has for us as He prays through us. It is on a level too deep for words. Normal language exhausts itself. The Bible calls this kind of prayer, powerful and effective. Practice it daily!!
