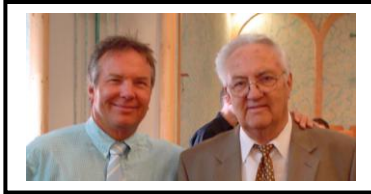


He can't talk but he can still pray!

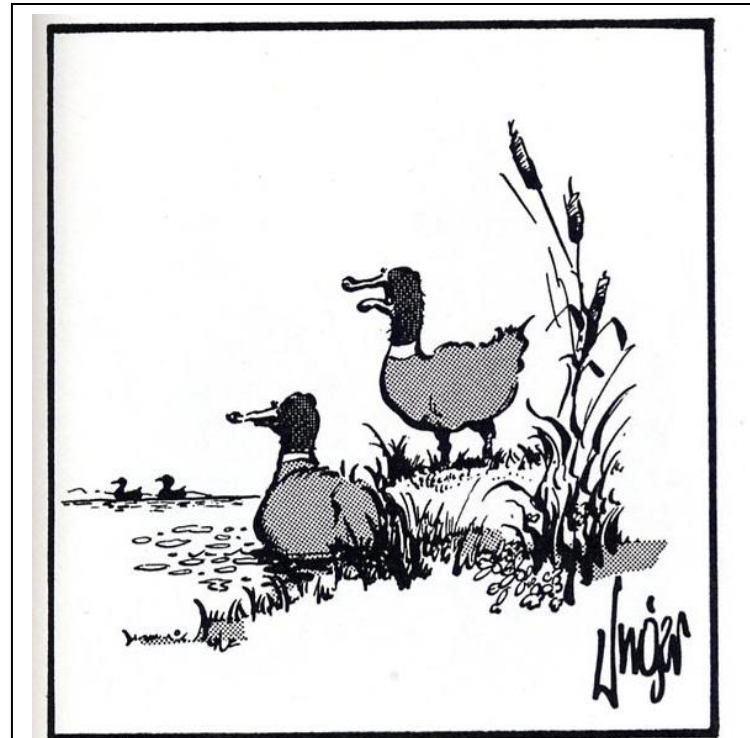
