God was in control, even in the pain and Paul knew it. See Jesus in your pain, see the trial for what it is, just a test, to know what's in your heart and mind. If Satan sees that your trial is not affecting your mind, but indeed you are drawing closer to the Lord, he will withdraw, his goal is to destroy you, not form Christ in you! It's up to you, how's the skull doing?
