

“We give great honor to those who endure under suffering”

How are you in the patience department? If you really have patience, you have settled the time issue. When we run out of patience we are in essence saying to God, “That’s enough”. We are putting a time line on our faith. But James says in 5:7, “be patient brothers until the coming of the Lord”. How long must we be patient? Until the Lord comes in and changes it! If you run out of patience, it’s because you have not settle some things and God is waiting on you to change them.

This truth is reinforced in v.8, “You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand.” Establish your heart that no matter what happens or how long it takes, you’re going to trust Him and wait for him to help you. The Lord is coming to help you, he’s right at the door, the day after you gave up was the day of deliverance for you, stay the course!

V9 tells us the attitude we need as we wait. “Do not grumble against one another brothers, lest you be condemned: behold, the judge is standing at the door!” When you’re suffering and it continues, the temptation is to grumble, the flesh doesn’t like it. God wants our attitude to be one of anxious anticipation for what He has promised!

Hold on dear ones, the judge is at the door, victory is closer than you think!
