This phrase kept coming to me in prayer recently. I found the verse in Isa.33:14. "Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with the everlasting burnings?" Of course this is a description of God who Paul called a "consuming fire".

The next verse answers the question. He who walks righteously and speaks uprightly. To be righteous means **to be "right"** by God's standards. To walk uprightly means to be "honest" in all we say and do.

He goes on to say that those who dwell with the everlasting burnings are those who reject making a profit by fraud, who stay far away from bribes, who refuse to listen to those who plot murder, who shut their eyes to all enticement to do wrong. **These are the ones who will dwell on high.** The rocks of the mountains will be their fortress of safety. Food will be supplied to them and they will have water in abundance. Your eyes will see the king in all his splendor and you will see a land that is very far off."

I believe this is a prophetic verse to this church. We, who change our behavior, do what is right, seek the Lord, will see the King in his glory! What mighty verses of promise! What mighty provision the Lord has provided. Let us never be confused by this, God has a standard and when we meet it we will be showered with his abundant blessings!
