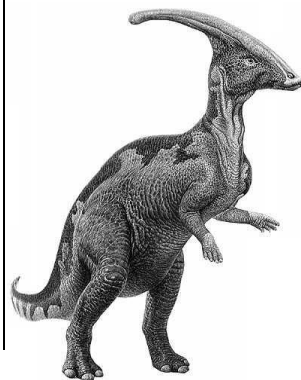
God give us a proper relationship with You so we can be acceptable on the day when we stand before You alone!
