Welcome to your new life!

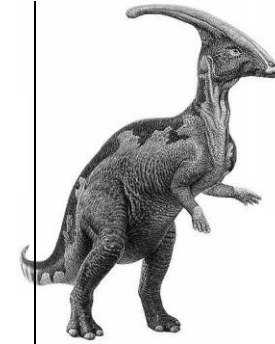
